Incompatibility between 4WDs and other passenger cars is a growing problem as the popularity of 4WDs increases in cities. When a passenger car is hit by the higher and heavier 4WD, the impact is made above the structures and safety features designed to distribute and absorb the energy of the impact, potentially negating the safety features of the normal passenger car and resulting in greater injury to the occupant than if the crash had occurred with another normal passenger vehicle.

Dr Lund plus experts from Australia will explore the issue and highlight the latest research in this area.
